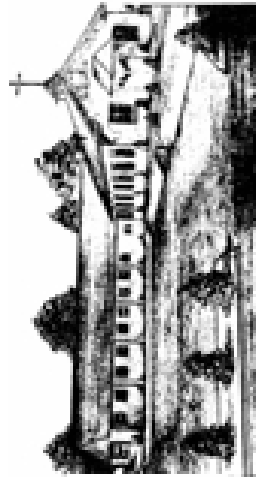

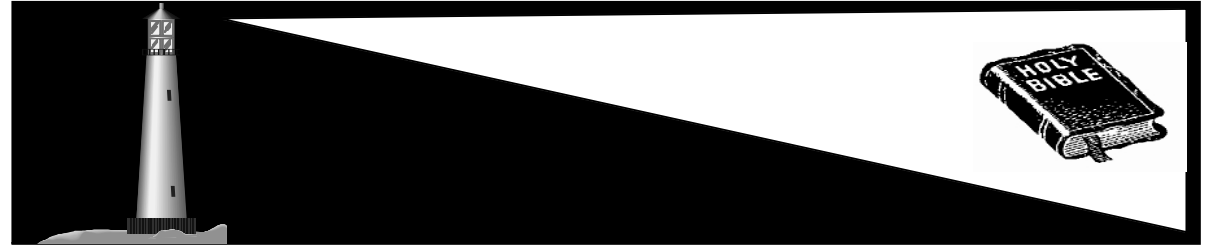

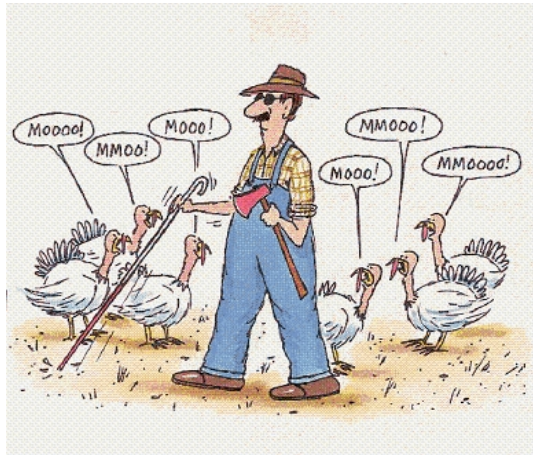

The Purpose of the Family

October, 28th, Sunday Evening
Luke 1:5-17

An angel of the Lord came to Zacharias while he was performing the duties of his office as a priest. The scriptures say that he and his wife were people who served the Lord the right way. They were being given a huge responsibility to raise the for-runner of the Messiah.

There are 5 principles that our families need to fulfill

1. Teach the Scripture – (Deuteronomy 4:9-10)

There are many things out there to build a family on (sports, education, good works, etc.), but the scriptures are the only foundation that will last. Without teaching the scriptures, the family will fall apart. There would be nothing to give them stability.

2. Worship God Together – (I Corinthians 16:19)

Aquila and Pricilla had started a church in their home. Their entire family had to be involved in the ministry of the Lord. The family is the place where people learn how to serve God. It is also the place to teach children how to read the Bible, Pray, and serve God.

3. Live in Unity – (Genesis 45:24, Psalm 133:1)

In a family you learn how to get along with other people. You deal with many different personalities and circumstances in a family setting that will prepare you for the future.

4. Teach Life Lessons – (Matthew 18:21-22)

There are lessons that are best learned in the Family. Forgiveness, patience, longsuffering, grace, mercy, love, and proper anger should not be left to strangers and the world to teach to our families.

5. Have Fun! – (Deuteronomy 12:7)
